### **FSRU Livorno Project**





Floating Storage Re-gasification Unit (FSRU) conversion project, popularly known as the FSRU Livorno project is a joint venture of Registro Italiano Navale (RINA) and Drydocks World Dubai. FSRUs are floating terminals where LNG is stored before being re-gasified on board. The project also involves the installation of a side by side berthing mooring system for the LNG carrier, a loading system (i.e. loading arms), LNG transfer system to regasification plant, a process plant for regasification, utilities including power generation and sea water systems, control, automation and communications systems. It is believed that this prestigious and innovative project will help strengthen Dubai's reputation as a global leader in the ship conversation industry.



Professor Preben Terndrup Pedersen, Professor of Maritime Structures, Department of Mechanical Engineering, Technical University of Denmark (DTU), Kgs. Lyngby, Denmark. He is well renowned personality who has redefined the maritime academic scenario through his contributions to the maritime academic arena. Prof. Preben Terndrup Pedersen, born October 15th 1940 is a Ph.D. degree holder of Mechanical Engineering from the Technical University of Denmark (DTU). In 1971-72 he was Research Fellow at Dept. of Engineering and Applied Physics at Harvard University, USA and in 1973 visiting researcher at Det Norske Veritas, Norway. In 1973 he was appointed Professor of Strength of Marine Structures at Department of Naval Architecture and Offshore Engineering at DTU. He was Vice-president of the Danish Academy of Technical Sciences between 1998-2002. In 2006 he was awarded the Davidson Medal from the Society of Naval Architects and Marine Engineers, USA for outstanding scientific accomplishment in ship research. He is a member of several reputed maritime academic institutions including the Danish Academy of Technical Sciences, the Norwegian Academy of Technical Sciences and Fellow of Royal Institute of Naval Architects, Fellow of Society of Naval Architects and Marine Engineers, US. He is also an advisor to A. P. Møller -Mærsk.
